It is Near—Even at the Doors

“This Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.” Matt. 24:14. The FULL GOSPEL that Jesus and His apostles preached is now fast spreading to all nations as a witness, and a sign to us that our Lord’s coming is near.

THE RESTORATION OF THE FAITH.

How soon after Pentecost the early church went into darkness. They lost the gifts, the power, the purity and the faith and went into deep darkness. Finally men were crawling up stairs and doing penance to get forgiveness of sins.

Then God raised up a man to preach justification by faith, and it became established in the church amid great opposition and persecution. Then the Word of God that had been hidden in convents and chained to pulpits was brought to light and put into the hands of the people through the printing press, and God began to put the Word back into the hearts of the people.

Time went on and He raised up another man to teach sanctification by faith. Some who dared to receive it and teach it were dragged about the streets by the hair of their head, but they stood, and the light of the doctrine of sanctification as a second work of grace has been shining in the church ever since.

Then God, in His divine mercy, put divine healing back into the church. Many have testified in their churches that God healed their bodies and have been forbidden to speak of it any more. But man cannot quench this thing. It is from heaven. It is of God. It is His Word. He has healed thousands since then, and the truth has come to stay, that healing is in the atonement of Jesus Christ.

Then He revealed the soon coming of the Lord. God has always had a people that would dare to stand for His truth when He revealed it. Many are teaching that when Christ comes into your soul, that is the second coming of Christ. Away with such teaching. Christ is coming as literally as He went away, for the angels said after He was taken up, as the disciples stood gazing upward, "This same Jesus that is taken up from you into heaven shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into heaven." And He has a people today that will believe it. When He comes, His brightness is going to draw them up to meet Him.

Then the time came that God brought the baptism of the Holy Ghost back into His church. Praise God it has come. Pentecost ushered in the early rain when Christ organized His church, but do you know the latter rain has come? And who are going to receive it? He is calling His church to come and partake of His supper, and sending His servants to tell them that all things are now ready. He has saved and sanctified many of them and now they can accept or reject the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Many are rejecting and opposing, and some even go so far as to say it is of the devil. But men cannot stop this latter rain. It has already spread over the United

States, Canada, Great Britain, Western Europe, Egypt, Africa, India, China, Australia, the islands of the sea, and old Jerusalem, where it first fell. God is back of it and it is going to remain in His church till He comes.

Some years ago, Hudson Taylor prophesied before a company of missionaries of the war between Russia and Japan and its outcome, which came to pass. He also said it would be followed by a great revival which would begin in Western Europe and spread over the world, and that this would be followed by the soon coming of the Lord. We have seen the great Wales revival, and following after it, the outpouring of the Spirit in Los Angeles three years ago, which has so rapidly spread over the world, thousands being saved, sanctified, baptized with the Holy Ghost and fire, speaking with new tongues, and miracles of healing being done in the name of Jesus, and saints are now looking, the world over, for the soon coming of our Lord.

The Wales revival stirred up the churches to praying for a revival. In Los Angeles, three years ago, the Methodists were praying for a revival, the Baptists wanted one in their churches, the Christian Alliance, and the missions were all praying for the outpouring of the Spirit, expecting it would come in their denomination, but, praise God, it came where He wanted it. It came without church creed or denomination but it came with the doctrine of the Lord Jesus Christ. It was through the prayers of all those people, but it fell where God wanted it, and He left it with the churches to humble themselves to accept the answers to their prayers. It was the will of God that Pentecost should fall on a few colored people who were sanctified and tarrying before Him for the power of God as on the day of Pentecost, believing that the same signs would follow as at the beginning. So the Holy Ghost fell on them as dew from heaven and the news spread to God's people everywhere.

This latter rain has been undenominational ever since. They have tried to organize and to corner up this mighty baptism of the Holy Ghost, but they will never do it. It is as free as the air you breathe. It makes no difference what church you belong to, if you will get down before God and get clearly justified and then get sanctified wholly, the baptism of the Spirit will come on your life.

Now our Christ wants to give the gifts to His body, the church. He has given a measure of faith, yet not the gift of faith. But He longs to give the gifts. He is trying to get a people that will lay aside every weight and be so separated from the world, and bring their minds so into captivity to the obedience of Christ that He can pour these gifts upon us. He is now burnishing up some of His people and humbling them down at His feet where they will be nothing and lean on nothing but Jesus alone. Then we can feel our weakness enough that He can make us strong. We have not reached the place where God can open the heavens and pour the gifts on us yet, so that we can say to the cripple, "Rise up and walk in the name of Jesus," and to the dead, "Arise." God is now healing in a wonderful way but we have not the gift of healing yet. We bless God for what He is doing: even the presence of some of His little ones in the sick chamber will heal the sick and anointed handkerchiefs are healing many as in the days of the apostles; but God wants us to tarry till we receive the real gift. He is going to restore the gifts back to His church and we believe they will be given before Jesus returns. Praise His name.

Many messages are being given through the unknown tongue and understood by those who hear them in their own language, that Jesus is coming soon.

God opened the deaf ears of an old man in San Jose. He was so deaf that we had to put our mouth to his ear to make him hear at all. But, oh, Jesus made him whole. He went out of the

house his face shining like an angel. Had never before had the witness of his salvation, but he got it when he was healed.

A little mother in Oakland came with her baby to the Mission to be healed, saying that unless God worked a miracle the doctors would have to operate on his leg in three days. The child was instantly healed and his mother came to the meeting afterward weeping for joy and praising God for his deliverance. We do not need a surgeon when we have Jesus Christ.

A child in the hospital in Portland was not expected to live. Its head had been operated on in two places. The saints took a handkerchief that had been anointed and prayed over and laid it on the child's head, and in two hours after that, the child was able to be taken home on the street car.

The last time we had the Lord's Supper in Portland, the Lord was saving, sanctifying and baptizing with the Holy Ghost, and all was going on as we took the Lord's Supper. Some of the saints fell under the power of God, and the Lord spoke to one sister and said that the gifts were soon to be given, and a number received the witness that we are soon to see God's power manifested in a marvelous way.

"A few days ago, the doctors said I would have to undergo an operation and I told them that Jesus would heal me and when the saints laid their hands on me the healing virtue of Jesus went through my body and I stand completely healed before you tonight as a living witness to Jesus. Who has more right to praise Jesus than I? I am glad that He saved my soul and I yielded my heart to Him and I am so glad that I have taken Him for my healer, Savior, sanctifier and baptizer. Oh, He has done so much for me. I praise my Savior."—Testimony in San Francisco.

Recently a man came to the altar who had been a sinner for 52 years. He hated this people but God brought him here. The Spirit said to one of the workers, "He has a devil that must be cast out of him." So taking the Word, "In my name shall they cast out devils," we went and rebuked the devil. And the man jumped to his feet and began praising God up and down the aisle and hugged the man that prayed for him, and said, "I love you. I hated you and used to hate to see your Wagon on the street, but now I love you." He is now rejoicing in the Lord.

One night when some workers from Portland were in the Mission in San Francisco, just as the altar call was made, some fell under the power and one got his baptism and immediately began to speak in tongues. A young man on the platform also went down under the power and had a vision of Jesus coming in the clouds with the angels with Him. Others fell all about the altar. Some were saved and sanctified. It was a wonderful night.

A man in Oakland who had crippled hands and was unable to work, had been a morphine fiend and used to sell shoe strings on the streets of Oakland for a living, got saved in the Apostolic Faith Mission. God baptized him with the Holy Ghost, and at the same time, the power began to work in his crippled hands and the fingers straightened out and his hands were perfectly healed. He can work now as well as anyone. He holds up his hands and testifies what God has done for him and is rejoicing in the Lord and is at work.

One night in San Francisco after a hard battle against all opposing forces, just as the altar call was made, the power fell and one of the workers saw a fire, as it were, burst out from the altar and the faces of the people changed and they pressed forward and filled the altar and the space about it. It was a time when souls found the Lord.

A young man in San Jose who had been around the world, was a drunkard, cigarette fiend and gambler. While he was lying in the delirium tremens at one time, he saw the name "Apostolic Faith Mission" come before him again and again. He had seen it in passing up the street but did not know what it meant. But when he got over the delirium tremens, he went and hunted up the place and went in and got saved. He gives a beautiful testimony of what God has done for him. The appetite for drink and cigarettes was instantly taken away from him. He is standing true and has a good position where he could hold none before.

I want to praise God for this lovely way. I love my Savior with all my heart. I am going all the way with Him. I tell you I am not ashamed of Him. Oh, I have Jesus in my heart, and where Jesus is it is heaven there. I have Jesus inside. Oh, I praise Him for all He has done for me. I cannot praise Him enough. —*A boy's testimony.*

A sister in San Francisco, whose mother had died of cancer, found that she had one also, and the doctor told her she must have it taken out right away, but she went to the Lord and took Him at His word and He has completely healed her.

A mother in Oakland came and asked prayers for her son, who was working in a theater and was a cigarette fiend. The saints prayed and the Lord took away the appetite for cigarettes from him and later removed him from the theater. This same mother asked prayers for her unsaved husband, and he was saved a few days afterward.

In the San Francisco Mission, there is a man who was Sergeant on the police force for years, who is now 76 years old and is baptized with the Holy Ghost and filled with the love of God. He says that when he gets up to speak in the Mission, he often sees Jesus with His arms outstretched, hanging on the cross with five bleeding wounds, inviting sinners to come.

These days as we get down before God, we hear it resounding in our ears that Jesus is coming soon. He wants His people to band together as never before and tell a lost world that He is coming soon.

Coming for His Bride.

He is coming in the clouds for His bride, and we shall be caught up to meet Him. (I Thess. 4:16,17.) His bride is not going through the tribulation but is going to be caught up in the air to the marriage supper of the Lamb. Just as soon as His bride is ready, Jesus is coming. We must hasten to be ready with oil, which is the Holy Ghost, in our vessels, with our lamps, for if we are not ready when He comes, the door will be shut. (Matt. 25:1-12.) Those that are going up when Jesus comes are the overcomers, those that have the "all things in common" spirit.

"As a Thief in the Night"

"The Father alone knows the day that is set. Jesus said, "But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no not the angels in heaven, but My Father only." He is coming as a thief in the night to steal away His jewels. Who are His jewels? The overcomers through the Blood of the Lamb. Those that are purified, made white and tried. Those that have had all manner of evil said about them falsely and borne it. They never failed to hold up the Bloodstained banner of the cross in their homes and everywhere they went. Jesus is going to catch away His people. It seems like a fairy tale to those that are not ready, but to those that are ready, it is a reality.

When Jesus said, “I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven,” it was prophetic of the last days. Then the great tribulation will begin. But just before that, the saints will be caught up. There are only a few overcomers, but Jesus is holding back the wrath of God on account of that few. And when they are caught away, the tribulation will burst forth and God will smite the earth with plagues and judgments.

He Will Reward His Saints.

At the marriage supper of the Lamb, the saints will be rewarded for their works. Luke 19:15. It is not what man sees that we will be rewarded for but what God sees that we did in the Spirit. If we did anything to be seen of men, we shall receive no reward for that. The prayers that are bottled up in golden bowls in heaven are those only that are prayed in the Spirit, and they are going to be poured out on the earth. How faithful we ought to be in prayer when we know that the prayers of the saints are being preserved in heaven. Christ will give us our rewards, some over ten cities, some over five. (Luke 19:17-19.)

Christ Revealed From Heaven.

Then He will come back with ten thousand of His saints in power and great glory, and all the holy angels with Him. Every eye shall see Him. Then will the knees bend and the tongues confess and call for the rocks and the mountains to cover them. But it will be too late. They will see the saints and martyrs of Jesus and we, the last saints, shall be with Him. Those that have the Herod spirit, the spirit that persecutes the Child Jesus, will behold Him.

The Earth Is Groaning for the Coming of Jesus.

The whole earth today is groaning for the coming back of Jesus. (Rom. 8:22,23.) Even the grass and trees are none of them growing as luxuriantly as they will be then. (Isa. 55:13.) All nature is dwarfed, waiting for the coming of Christ.

And how much more are we groaning. We know that we are washed in the Blood and baptized with the Holy Ghost, and walking in all the light of the truth, but there is something in our hearts that is longing and groaning for redemption. The mighty power that brought Jesus from the dead is going to transform us. These bodies are to be redeemed and glorified. We shall leave off these old grave clothes and put on incorruption. It will pay us to suffer with Christ and be full overcomers, for there is a wonderful reward for those that endure unto the end.

Jesus Only.

This work is not to build up some great organization but to get souls saved and get them into oneness with Christ. We are recognizing God as the head in this work. We are done with the flesh and man-made plans of building up churches. It is, "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith the Lord." Our doctrine is the doctrine of Christ and His apostles. Our creed is the creed of the Book. Our credentials come right from heaven. The authority that backs us up is not from bishops, popes or missionary boards, but from God.

When you tarry at the feet of Jesus and receive the Third Person of The Trinity, God slips the ring of authority on your finger. And when you lose that you might as well take a back seat. God's ministers are recognized by the power on their lives. Paul says, "I will know not the speech of them that are puffed up but the power." If Paul should come back and judge the ministers by the power on their lives, they would most of them have to go out of business.

God's ministers are a flame of fire. He wants men and women on fire. The Holy Ghost is dynamite and fire in your soul. He is the lightning. He strikes men down with conviction through the preaching of the Word, slays and makes alive.

The Secret of Power.

The power is continually on the work in Portland. Why? Because they are always working for souls. There is a body of saints that are united, filled with love and standing in the doctrines of Christ. There is no compromise, fanaticism or false doctrine. No collections for work or workers have ever been taken since Pentecost fell, but the work stands for faith in God and a free Gospel.

The saints keep busy getting souls saved. It is their meat and drink to lead a soul to Jesus or pray for the sick. After the day's work is over and the altar cleared at night, they will pray over handkerchiefs for the sick at a distance and pray over sacks of papers to be mailed. Then they will often kneel at the altar and pray for the faith once delivered unto the saints. One night long after midnight, some saints were still in the Mission and a man came in who had got under such conviction that he could not sleep and came back and got saved.

This Gospel has started people back to reading their Bible. They have stopped gossiping and gone to reading their Bibles. It is nothing to see people studying the Word on the street cars and on the boat and even as we pass the bridge, we can see some leaning on the rail and reading the Bible. You need to ask Jesus to save your soul if you do not love the Word of God, because a soul that is under the Blood has a hunger for the Word. These people are crying out day and night, "Oh if we only had more time to study the Word."

This is not a Gospel that tears down homes, but builds up homes. It has brought such joy and peace to homes and families. There are many happy homes where father, mother, and children have been brought in and baptized with the Holy Ghost. They are homes of praise and rejoicing and they are going out and telling the glad story. We teach the mothers to do their work well, keep the home and children clean and get their husband's meals on time. A woman in Minneapolis, who had been sick and was hardly able to do her work, came to the Mission as a backslider and was saved and healed. Her husband had been fighting the work, but when he came home and found his wife healed and the work all done up, he said that if that was what this Gospel was doing for homes, he wanted to go. He went to the Mission himself and got saved and sanctified and baptized with the Holy Ghost. They both were baptized the same night.

The Spirit Asks the Blessing.

This Pentecostal blessing is so sweet. When you gather around the table to bless the food in Jesus' name, the Lord blesses it Himself. In San Francisco as the workers gathered in one of the precious homes where they have the "all things in common spirit" and all in one accord, the power fell on the table and all were filled with the Holy Ghost. The Spirit Himself sang through us and asked the blessing through one brother in the unknown tongue, which was understood by an Italian in his own language. It was, "*Manciate. Questo e benedetto. Siate buoni soldati. Lora e vi cini.*"—*Eat this. It is blest. Be good soldiers. The time is nigh.* How many times the Spirit has said that the time is near. We ought to be watching and ready for His coming. The dear saints felt honored to have Jesus speak a message and give the interpretation at their table and they have it written on a motto in their humble kitchen as a remembrance.

"Let Not Your Heart Be Troubled."

Jesus said to His disciples when He was about to go away and He perceived that their hearts were troubled, "Let not your heart be troubled, ye believe in God, believe also in Me." Oh, our God wants us to believe in Jesus. He is the same today and He is in the world in spirit and is looking down into the hearts of men and women and reading their thoughts. He can see if you have a broken heart and you need the oil. Oh, God says to you, "Let not your heart be troubled, believe in Me."

Oh, have you tasted, have you seen, do you know that the Lord is good? Hallelujah to God, He blots out sin and takes out pride and everything that annoys, and He will give you peace like a river flowing in your soul. The billows can roll and the storms howl but there is something down in your soul that says, "Peace be still. Let not your heart be troubled."

A mother in Portland had a boy who had been afflicted with spasms for years. She said the death rattle was in his throat, but it ceased and she believed he was dead. But the power of God brought him back and he raised up in bed and asked his mother for a drink of water. God is

confirming His Word with signs and wonders in a mighty way. The reason there are not more signs seen is because His Word is not wrought out in the lives of His people.

When the disciples had been toiling all night and had caught nothing, Christ stood on the shore and called to them, “Children, have ye any meat?” Then He spoke the word with authority and made the sea give up its fishes. Jesus is saying to every one of us, “Children, have ye any meat?” Oh, He is the meat. He is the Bread of Life. He is saying, “Cast the net on the right side and ye shall find.” If you obey the voice of Jesus, you shall find life more abundant.

FAITH.

We must have faith that the Blood of Jesus Christ can cleanse us from all sin, and through that faith we are born again. We must believe that Jesus is the Christ. We have never seen him, our hands have never handled Him, but we believe the report that we have heard of the prophets and apostles. We know that He died and shed His Blood and arose. Jesus is the beginning and ending of our faith.

Now we have faith enough to believe that He can and does blot out our sins and we have the witness in our souls that we are the children of God, we have the beginning of faith. Then we can have faith that the Blood will be applied and take out the old carnal nature of sin. We receive it through faith in God. "By grace are ye saved through faith."

Then if God can give us faith enough to believe that Christ can eradicate sin and make us free from the pollution and nature of sin and death and transform us and renew us by the Spirit, cannot we have faith enough in God to trust Him to do all things? He wants us to have faith in God. And believing the thing that we see is not faith, it is believing what we do not see. "Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

People come to get healed and there is a doubt in their heart whether the Lord will heal them now. But if we believe that the Son of God that can forgive sins is also able to touch our mortal body, we shall be healed. When? Now, right now. If we will believe it, we have receiving faith, and it will be done unto us.

As far as the world was concerned, Abraham and Sarah were dead, but God told him his seed should be as the sand of the sea and as the stars of heaven. Think of the impossibility of his being the Father of nations. Now God loves us just as much as He did Abraham, and if we get down before Him and ask Him for a thing and believe it, He will do it for us. God has promised us great things, but we must have faith. Often the promise is not fulfilled, because we do not believe. It is one thing for God to promise and another thing for us to have faith that it shall be done. His promise and our faith linked together bring it to pass. If we will hold on, He will fulfill it. We can lose it if we lose faith. He will promise, and then we must keep our faith up, that the thing will be brought to pass. All we get is only through faith in Jesus Christ. If we ask Him in faith nothing wavering, we shall see the thing fulfilled.

It is the Father's good pleasure to give us the kingdom. It is the Father's pleasure that we should be well. It is His pleasure that we should have faith, for without faith it is impossible to please Him. Faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. The people today that are full of faith are not those always that have read the Word so much, but those who have it wrought out in their lives, those who believe the Word of God. They believe it enough that they have it in their hearts and it is working out in their lives. Oh, it means so much to have the Word of God wrought out in our souls. There is nothing impossible with God, and if you get the Word, the Blood and the Spirit in your life, you can step out on the promises and see Him perform miracles in your own life and the lives of others.

How we praise God that we have the Word, the faith of God, coming back into the church. Jude said, "Contend earnestly for the faith that was once delivered unto the saints." God is trying to get a people that will trust for the little things, and then He will give them the greater things. He cannot trust us with the "faith once delivered," if we have not faith for our night's lodging, clothes to put on our backs and our daily food. He is looking for people today that will

launch out and trust God, and when He gets a people that believe Him and can trust Him for food and raiment, He can give us more faith. He wants us to look up and believe that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. He is the Author of our faith, the One that starts you and the One that causes you to go on unto perfection.

If Jesus looked forward to the joy set before Him, how much more ought we. It is wonderful to be saved, and then the greater glory when Christ comes and enthrones Himself in our soul, and then when the mighty glory of the Spirit comes down, it seems there is not room enough to contain it and it just overflows and waters every place where we go. But it will be a greater joy when we meet Jesus and see His face and cast our crowns at His feet and are forever with the Lord.

Jesus is now interceding before the throne that our faith fails not. While multitudes fail, these little words come before us, "He abideth faithful." Do you know that Jesus will abide faithful? Every one may fail but you can keep those words in your hearts, "He abideth faithful." He will finish what He has begun in us if we will judge Him faithful.

"Consider Him who endured." Oh, when we get weary and grow weak in our faith, let us look at Jesus, who endured such contradiction of sinners that we might have the fountain of life in us. He gave the faith unto the church that we might not use any carnal weapons, but the weapon of faith in Jesus Christ in our souls.

If it were not for the living faith that comes into our souls through the Word of God, when your family is going into sin, you would give up hope; but through faith in God, you look up and hope against hope. This hope in the soul maketh not ashamed. Hallelujah to God. How many mothers have looked at their children in sin and said, "I wonder if there is power enough in the Blood to take this child out of sin and get them to take the narrow way? Yes, there is power, but we must believe God. As long as there is a doubt in our mind, that is not faith. You must look unto Jesus nothing wavering. "He that spared not His own Son but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things."

A CHURCH ON A MOUNTAIN.

A brother in Santa Rosa dreamed that he saw on a mountain a large statue of a woman in solemn pose. (We know that God does give dreams, for He says, "*Your old men shall dream dreams.*") The brother told this dream to some of the saints and they said, "The woman represents a church on the mountains. The Lord wants you to go up on the mountain and preach the Gospel." He had a little claim up on the mountain and he and his wife went up and pitched their tent. The enemy would tell him, "There is no use for you to hold meetings, they are too far down in sin for you to tackle." But they announced meetings in the tent where they were living.

The children came at first and became interested. They told the parents and they finally came. Then they held meetings in a little maple grove on a small flat and the fire began to fall and the Spirit to work. The Lord sent them another helper. thirty pounds in weight. He used to be found in an old shed, drunk, and now his face is shining. Where these men once visited the saloons and spent their money, now they pass by the saloons singing and praising God. Over thirty souls were saved and eight received the baptism of the Holy Ghost. The meetings are still going on.

“Popular trees have grown up in God’s fruit bearing orchard. The result, see, see! The result we have in our midst. Oh, His hands were pierced for you, and His side was pierced for you and me. He bore the cruel cross. He bore the scoffs and jeers and scorn of men.”

God Will Judge.

God is speaking to the world through earthquakes and judgments today. The earthquake of December 25th in Messina, Italy, was said to be the most destructive of life of any known in history. Men’s hearts are failing them for fear today. When they hear of earthquakes in other lands, they fear it will come to them. After the great white throne judgment, we shall see men and women that have scorned this salvation, this holiness and this baptism cast down into a burning hell. Today if ye will hear His voice, harden not your heart. Oh, accept this salvation of Jesus Christ.

“He Shall Guide You.”

The Holy Ghost is the Teacher of teachers. He knows the Word of God. You can talk with Him and ask Him for yourself. It is the sweetest thing to get alone with Him and let Him open the Scriptures to you. He is the interpreter of the Word, the Spirit of truth to guide you into all truth. Many times He calls out the chapters or verses to read and then opens the Scriptures. A young man in Portland got saved in the Mission and had been a Catholic and did not know the Bible. He belonged to the Catholic lodge and the priests told him that if he broke his lodge vow, he could never be forgiven, that it was an unpardonable sin to break a vow. The boy was

troubled about it, but the Spirit spoke to him, telling him to read Lev. 5:4, 5. He was trying to find it in his Testament till one of the saints told him it was in the Old Testament and found it for him. It showed him that God did forgive men for broken vows. The Spirit also told him to read Jer. 17:5-8 to teach Him to trust in the Lord and not in the lodge for employment.

You see a beautiful ship gliding over the waves and you can see only a little smoke coming out of the smokestack, but there is a great engine out of sight, and a great arm moving that ship. God wants us to have that great arm down in our souls. The power of God is the engine down in our innermost being that is propelling us on heavenward. The world cannot see it, but it is going on just the same and we are going on up and up, and some day we will land at the side of Jesus in the skies. He puts that power in every soul, a power that says, "As for me, I am going through with Jesus." Oh, there is an echo in every soul that has the Blood on their heart that they are going through with Jesus.

"The fruit of the Spirit is love." That means to love everybody. Put yourself on the witness stand and search your heart. Do you love everybody? Ask God, and if you do not love them, plead the Blood until you can love them enough to give them your "cloak also" if they take away your coat.

"Whosoever shall fall upon that stone shall be broken; but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder." If we fall on this Stone, Jesus, and are broken, our wills broken, our hearts broken, we shall receive salvation and power from heaven; but if this Stone falls on us, it will grind us to powder. If we are falling on Jesus and become empty and broken vessels and fulfilling all righteousness, the Stone is not going to fall on us. Oh, let us fall on that Stone and be broken.

All prayer should be directed to the Father in the name of Jesus. We praise Jesus, but we pray to God the Father through the Son. Jesus is our high priest at the right hand of God making intercession for us. Everything we receive from God comes through the merits of Jesus. He said, "Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My name, He shall give it you." We should honor the name of Jesus. The Word tells us, in the name of Jesus to lay hands on the sick, and in the name of Jesus, to cast out devils and to "Do all in the name of the Lord Jesus." There is power in His name.

Discernment is given us by the Holy Spirit that we might restore a brother or sister in the spirit of meekness. If you have discernment, the first thing you will do, is to pray for the person and watch the case to see if there is a change. Then go to them alone in the Spirit of Jesus and tell them as gently as you can about the fault, and tell them that Jesus will help them. Many that have had the baptism of the Holy Ghost have taken on a real harsh spirit. Now if your discernment is not in the spirit of love, it is no longer in the Spirit. It has turned to accusing the brethren. The young saints need to be advised, prayed with and nurtured in the right way. And the word spoken in the Spirit lodges in the heart while the other rankles. When you see the difference, you will pray for the spirit of discernment and God will give it to you.

EXTRACTS FROM PRECIOUS LETTERS.

Kaitara, New Zealand. It is with joy I am able to give my testimony of the baptism of the Holy Ghost. I cannot find words to express the joy that filled my soul as the Spirit of the Lord sang and talked through me in the unknown tongue. The Lord gave me the assurance of sanctification on August 3d, and my baptism on November 11th.

West Africa. While I was in Sierra Leone, the dear Lord sent a revival among the Kroo people there. The mission was under the Church of England and the result of the revival was 13 souls saved for God. They had never seen anything like the demonstration of the Spirit as was manifested in that revival. When the power fell on them, they shook like leaves on a tree during a hard storm. Some fell out on the floor and I felt as if I was in Azusa Mission. It lasted ten evenings.

Assiout, Upper Egypt. Many, many are weeping their way to the fullness of God. The Holy Ghost has fallen in mighty power, convicting of sin. Souls have been saved, sanctified and baptized with the Holy Ghost, speaking in tongues and casting out devils. Our big brother, who was baptized and went to Kharthoom in the Soudan, had mighty power and great wisdom. When he opened his mouth the Lord opened the heavens. His very voice seemed to rend the heavens. He was understood to speak in French and Italian. Before his baptism he spoke only English and Arabic. Real miracles of healing have taken place here. We give Him all the glory. Praise His name. He is worthy of the praise.

Mobile, Ala. The Lord sent me to St. Louis, Mo. Fourteen souls were baptized with the Holy Ghost and fire and seven or more were sanctified and are tarrying for their Pentecost. The meeting ran twenty-four days. When I left, the fire was falling and is still falling. Many hungry souls are there.

Wyandotte, Okla. I received the roll of papers. Praise the Lord for them. We will be here a short time and then go further south. His father-in-law cried all night and his brother-in-law came to the altar next night.

Plainfield, Ind. The following is her testimony:

He has put a peace in my heart that was not there before. He took me out of the old dead churches and gave me this salvation.

When I came here on January 27th, my left limb was three inches shorter than the other, but on the morning of the 28th, I was not lame. He lengthened it and now I can walk as straight as anyone.

When for four years, I could not see out of one eye, every nerve in my eye was dead, He has put in new nerves and now I can see out of it better than ever before. For eight long years I wore glasses, but now Jesus has taken the glasses off and I do not need them. He has opened my eye, and He has not only done that, but opened the eyes of my soul.

For nine long years I had not been able to hear in one ear. The doctors told me I would never hear in that ear. The doctor said the drum was completely gone, but praise God I can hear with it today. Oh, Jesus is so good to me. O glory to Jesus.

For nine years I have not been able to breathe through my nostrils. The doctors said it was a bleeding cancer. Whatever it was, Jesus healed it and now I can breathe through my nose. Jesus has made me over new. Glory to Jesus. He is mine. Who could do it but Jesus? I don't want the world, I don't want cards or the theater, but I do, I do want Jesus.

A man came to the Mission in Oakland very drunk and limping painfully. Some were going to put him out, but we told them to let him stay. After the meeting, he was invited to come to the altar and had to be helped there. He could not kneel down on account of his leg that was stiff with rheumatism, so he sat down on a chair and the workers prayed for his healing.
