Perils of The day.

"This know that in the last days, perilous times shall come." We are living in the very last days, on the threshold of the coming of Jesus Christ. Follow current events; put them alongside the Words of Jesus Christ (Matt. 24), and you will know the time is at hand.

We are in the last days. Soon the skies shall part, and the glorious Christ come for His own. This world has grown old in sin and sorrow. The 6,000 years of its span length is nearly worn away. Signs prophesied thousands of years ago have been fulfilled in our day; and the Book of God tells us when these things come to pass the Savior and His Kingdom are at hand --"It is near, even at the doors,"

There is an awful solemnity in the times in which we are living. History has never known such a generation as the one in which we now live. The signs the world have witnessed in the last few years undoubtedly point to the one of which Christ said, "Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away till all be fulfilled." (Luke 21:32.)

We see "the fig tree putting forth its leaves." The Jew of the entire world are awakening. A great tide of emigration is sweeping to the Holy Land. The world conference of Zionists is waiting and expecting the mandate that will restore to them their land, and they can become a nation. Some have thought the Jews would buy it back, but God said that it should be given them "without money." (Isa. 52:3.) The land will be restored and the sacred temple site. Prophecy is rapidly being fulfilled.

We do not know what may happen in a single night in these times.

Thrones have crumbled, dynasties have fallen, kings have lost their crowns. Who would have believed that the Czar of Russia, the Kaiser of Germany and the Emperor of China would lose their thrones? The frightful War of Nations which has just closed is the war of which Jesus Christ spoke (in Matt. 24:7, 8). "Nation shall rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines and pestilences and earthquakes in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows." Just cast your eyes over Europe, and remember when you are looking at that vast devastation, that God foretold these things in the last days.

Ten Million Slain in Battle.

The deaths in the last war were simply beyond imagination. More than 59 million were mobilized, vast armies. There were over 33 million casualties, killed and wounded. Of these, 19 million were wounded, and nearly six million are permanent cripples and wrecks. Seven million prisoners were missing. Of these many were killed. The total number of dead certainly reached ten million. This number refers only to the fighting men. For every soldier killed, several civilians laid down their lives. And millions were swept away by epidemic diseases, caused by hunger and conditions of the war. Today millions are still in awful suffering.

In the Wake of the War.

In northern France hundreds of thousands of refugees have returned to their homes, only to find a bleak and dreary wilderness of ruin. In a great belt of land, every human habitation has been completely obliterated. As far as the eye can reach, where once were prosperous homes, all is desert, shell holes filled with water, ruined barbed-wire entanglements, the very ground treacherous with mines and unexploded ammunition of all kinds. Thousands are living in cellars and dugouts, destitute and sorrowful pioneers. Not only in France, but in other ruined lands, there is terrible suffering as an after effect of the war.

"The Beginning of Sorrows"

is in the earth. These things are the sure fulfillment of prophecy, and point definitely to the soon coming of the Lord. No such was ever seen. We have never realized half its horrors, the battle fields heaped with the slain and mangled, scenes of cruelty and frightfulness that men call "hell." The last year, the year 1918, was called the year of blood. The last battle lasted nearly eight months and was without parallel in history.

There is famine and great suffering in parts of Europe, in Armenia and Siberia. From Finland, a Christian brother writes us: "Finland has suffered much in these last days. Many families are naked, hundreds of fathers are lying in mother earth, and thousands behind the prison bars. Many families have starved to death, others through lack of food, are nothing but skin and bones. Some, their bodies have swollen out of figure for want of food. Some places they have eaten most anything their hands reached.

"One Christian family now with us tell how their feet and faces were swollen. They had no money to buy food, were crying to God. One went and dug in a potato field until he found a few old potatoes from last year. He came home rejoicing and praising God, that He in His mercy gave them food."

Daniel's Prophecy:

"Shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased," (Dan. 12:4) has certainly been fulfilled. So has the prophecy of Nahum: "The chariots shall be with flaming torches in the day of His preparation, and the fir trees shall be terribly shaken. The chariots shall rage in the streets, they shall jostle, one against another in the broad ways: they shall seem like torches, they shall run like lightnings." (Nah. 2:3, 4.)

Railways cover the earth, steamers track the sea. Wonderful inventions multiply. News is flashed by telegraph, cables and wireless. We read the events of the day in the morning and evening newspapers. In one generation, we have gone from the ox carts to the flying machine.

We have had the automobiles for 20 years. They have become a familiar feature of the streets and broad highways. Between six and seven millions are on the streets of the United States alone. Many are ignorant that these things are a perfect fulfillment of the Word of God, written centuries ago.

Airplanes are flying from two to thirty thousand feet in the air, at the rate of sixty to two hundred miles an hour, over land and sea, receiving and sending wireless messages on their flight, riding calmly over mountains and raging seas, carrying mail and passengers. It is the swiftest method of travel ever used by mortals; and in ten years, if Jesus tarries, the heavens above us may be as filled with aircraft as the highways of today are with motor cars.

The Manner of His Coming.

The very moment of His departure, two men stood by in white apparel and said, "This same Jesus shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into Heaven." (Acts 1:11.) He is coming in the clouds, "with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trump of God," and His people shall be caught up." (1 Thess. 4:16, 17.) The dead shall hear His voice (John 5:28), shall be raised and changed (I Cor. 15: 51, 52), received unto Himself (John 14:3).

Afterwards He shall stand on the same Mount of Olives (Zech. 14:4; Acts 1:12), coming in flaming fire, with power and great glory (II Thess. 1:8; Matt. 24: 30), His saints with Him (I Thess. 3:13; Jude 14). Every eye shall see Him (Rev. 1:7). He will destroy the Antichrist (II Thess. 2:8). All nations will be gathered unto Him (Matt. 25:32). The saints shall reign with Him (Dan. 7:18-27; Rev. 5:10). Every knee shall bow (Isa. 45:23; Phil. 2:10, 11). All nations shall serve Him (Ps. 72:11; Zech. 14:9).

Just as the Word Foretold.

As truly as God literally fulfilled the promise of the first coming of Jesus, so will He fulfill the second coming. The first coming of Christ, was it not literally and perfectly fulfilled? In the Old Testament there are 83 promises of Christ, which were exactly and literally fulfilled while He was on earth.

He was born of a virgin (Isa. 7:14), at Bethlehem (Micah 5:2), a "Man of Sorrows" (Isa. 53. entire chapter), sold for thirty pieces of silver (Zech. 11:12), His hands and feet pierced (Ps. 22:16), His garments parted (Ps. 22:18), Not a bone of His body broken (Ex. 12:46), He saw no corruption (Ps. 16:8-10). Every prophecy was fulfilled to the letter.

Now there are 318 verses in the New Testament that declare His second coming, and the very manner of His coming. They are also to be fulfilled to the letter. Some of these days, He will have come already, and if we could ask, "How did it take place?" The answer would be, "Just as the Word foretold." The Jews were slow of heart to believe all that the prophets had spoken of

Him. Today people are slow of heart to believe all that was spoken of His glorious second advent.

The Approach of Great Events.

Events prophesied thousands of years ago are taking place. Over nineteen centuries have passed since the birth of Him who was born to be earth's King, and by whose era we count the years. When the clock of the centuries shall strike the appointed hour, in spite of scoffers and unbelievers, our King will return to this earth.

Jerusalem is in the hands of Christians for the first time in sixteen centuries. The Zionist movement is actually pushing the work, for the restoration of Palestine, the Jewish homeland. Jerusalem will be the "City of the Great King." "The Lord will again choose Jerusalem." The Jews will again be the chosen people of the Lord, for they will accept Jesus Christ as their King, after going through the awful tribulation that is coming upon the whole earth. It is the unfulfilling prophecy of God's Word.

The Jew's are God's fig tree, a sign unto us. When we see them returning to their own land, and becoming a nation, we know that summer is nigh at hand. It means the "Hope of Israel" is coming. The Jews have been scattered for 19 centuries. It was prophesied that they shall be scattered and become a byword, and the "wandering Jew" has been a byword for these 19 centuries. But God has promised, "I will bring them again into their land that I gave unto their fathers." (Jer. 16:15). "They shall no more be pulled up out of their land" (Amos 9:15). They shall stand up a great nation (Eze. 37), and shall seek the Lord their God and David their King in the latter days (Hos. 3:4, 5).

God brought His people out of Egypt at the appointed time. "And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame day, it came to pass that all the hosts of the Lord went out from the land of Egypt." (Ex. 12:41; Gen. 15:13). Again when they had been in captivity in Babylon seventy years, God brought them out exactly as He had promised (Jer. 29:10; Dan. 9:2).

The Jews are now looking for the establishment of a nation of their own, where they can again have their temple at Jerusalem, where the "Blood of atonement can be offered." We see the great movement of Zionism; we see the Jews persecuted and longing to return. It is a sign to us of the Lord's coming.

Will His Coming Be Sudden?

It will be "as the lightning." It will be unexpected, the world unprepared. It will be "as a thief in the night." "For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth." (Luke 21:35.) It may be just upon us. The people in the days of Noah saw no sign of the flood, till it was right upon them. And "As the days of Noah were so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be." Matt. 24:37-39.)

"Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot." (Luke 17:28-30) The people of Sodom saw no sign of the fiery judgment that was to fall. When Lot warned them, it seemed to them as idle tales. It

came suddenly. As soon as Lot went out of Sodom, the smoke of the city arose as the smoke of a great furnace.

The great crisis of the world is nearer than many suppose. The faith of God's people has been for ages; that as God created the earth in six days, and rested the seventh day; and as a day is with Him as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day; therefore six thousand years would be the world's toiling week, and the seventh period would be the millennium of rest and peace and righteousness, during which Christ and His saints of the first resurrection will reign with Him on earth, and satan will be bound (Rev. 20).

All great men and the mass of people in general believe we are on the verge of some unknown change. Thinking men tell us we are nearing a crisis in the world. The English press says that the only assurance against war is the League of Nations and that the fevered preparations for war, the increase of armies, navies and munitions, will provoke another war. There is a lull today, a calm, but "rumors of wars," strikes, anarchy and revolution abound.

Is this a lasting peace? Will there be another war? There is a fear, an unrest in the hearts of the people, but the children of God are prepared for any event. The Word of God foretells of wars that are yet to come and a Great Tribulation; and it tells of a lasting peace, and that will be when Jesus Christ comes to reign--not until then.

The war drove many to their knees. It opened and softened the hearts of people for a time. Thousands called on God to save them in the day of battle, and thousands at home prayed, and they know that God answered. The nations were called upon to uncover and bow their hearts at a certain hour of the day, before the God of Heaven. The awful cloud covered the earth. Thousands went on their knees in prayer. The war ceased.

People will pray in time of suffering and then forget God. But God is calling on men to repent and turn from their evil way to serve the true and living God. The world is still in grave peril. Oh, that God would send a mighty old time revival of salvation to the whole round world that sinners might turn to God and repent before it is too late.

BACK AMONG THE OLD MINING CAMPS."

For years you would find me back among the old mining camps of Idaho and Montana, traveling with the miners, the railroad men, the gamblers, seeking for the pleasures of the world, going into the ball room, the gambling hall, the theaters, the skating rinks, looking for something to

satisfy. But how I praise and thank God today, that what the old world could not do for me, with all its sham and glitter, Jesus did for me nine years ago when I came into this Mission.

HOW A PRISONER WAS SAVED.

I received the little paper. What an inspiration such a message brings to a poor downcast man behind the old gray walls. I remember when I stood and looked a dear dying mother in the face, when only ten years old, and promised her I would meet her in that beyond. And do you think I could fail my promise with a loving mother?

You asked me how I found God. I had a close friend here in this place, and I and he would talk on the Bible every chance we got. And one Sunday he said, "Here is a paper I want you to read," and he gave me an old Apostolic Faith paper. And just as soon as I saw the big headlines where your electric light shines, and reads, JESUS, THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD, it seemed that I was struck with conviction. I read some of the testimonies.

And in the lonely cell, I went down on my knees and asked God to make me every whit whole. And this was while all the men slept. God is in the prison the same as anywhere. He is the Savior of sinners.

If you give your life to God tonight, really yield your heart to God, He will take you out of trouble. You will find him operating on that heart of yours. You will be able to stand before the whole world, and tell them that God saved you, and you can live the life you want to live. No man ever lived, that gave God his life, but the favor and smile of God rested on that man.

The Gospel By Airplane. "The Sky Pilot."

The first Airplane in the world purchased for the express purpose of carrying the Gospel.

"If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; even there shall Thy hand lead me, and Thy right hand shall hold me."

The Gospel Airplane arrived in Portland February 18th, after completing a 2500-mile trip from Tulsa, Oklahoma, via the southern route, stopping along the way at different points where Gospel literature was given out and talks given to the crowds that gathered upon landing, and in a church on one occasion.

It certainly was a wonderful sight to see, the Messenger in the air that is carrying the "Glad News" to souls. We received letters from people in the South before the Airplane reached here, that had received the "Message from the Skies" from this God-sent means of spreading the "Glad Tidings of Great joy." More than 500 people were on the ground to welcome him, and a royal welcome he received. It did seem so wonderful to see that old ship come into sight, just like a little bird, and get larger and larger, until at last it circled over our heads and lit on the Curtiss Fields.

As the ship would, fly over the different towns, the wheels would no more than touch the ground till the whole town would be out, it seemed, and there would be a great opportunity to speak to them and get the papers before them, and tell them about the Gospel. They would immediately close schools and the pupils and teachers would make a rush to the fields where the machine landed.

This trip was not made especially for the purpose of holding meetings but to deliver the plane to head-quarters at Portland, Oregon, from which place it will make trips to different parts of the country to hold meetings and distribute literature. Great interest was manifest in the plane, which was purchased for the express purpose of spreading the Gospel over the land. We have received letters already from those who have received the paper from the airplane, requesting our prayers and help for their spiritual welfare.

Throughout most of the journey the weather was very unfavorable, and they encountered many rain storms and hazardous weather along the way, but on every occasion where treacherous places were met, God always opened a way of escape and the trip was very successful, considering time of year in which it was made.

Many places at which they landed the people never had seen an airplane before, and immediately upon landing, large crowd gathered and a fine opportunity was afforded for telling them the Story and giving out these papers which have meant so much to many who have-received them.

The following is a copy of one of the dodgers that was given out on the trip across the country:

BRINGS YOU A MESSAGE FROM THE SKIES.

The airplane has proved its usefulness in late months, both in war and in peace, and is in keeping with the spirit of the age in which we live; and realizing the need throughout the land, of the speedy spread of the Gospel, The Apostolic Faith Mission, with head-quarters at the Corner of Front and Burnside Streets, Portland, Oregon, and branch Missions up and down the Coast and in the east, have purchased a new Airplane for this express purpose. This little message carries with it an invitation to our Mission at the Corner of Front and Burnside Streets, Portland, Oregon, one of the largest missions in the country, seating one thousand persons, large crowd every night, special singing, large orchestra. You will enjoy every minute.

Located under the big electric sign, fifty feet high and seventy feet broad, flashing out
"JESUS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD."

Some of the Details of the Trip Follow:

"After leaving Tulsa, Oklahoma, January 26th, late in the afternoon, we landed at Post Field, the government flying field in Lawton, Oklahoma, for gas. After flying over Oklahoma City and other small towns, and dropping literature, we ate our lunch in the air at about four thousand feet altitude. Flying out of Oklahoma, into Texas, we passed over some very rugged country in which landing fields were very scarce. At about five o'clock in the afternoon we ran into a heavy fog bank, after having just passed over the little town of Roaring Springs, Texas, and not knowing how far it was to the next town, we turned around and prepared to land at Roaring Springs. After circling the town for some time, seeking for a good landing field, which seemed quite hard to find, after throwing out some literature, we came down and landed in a large corn field, which proved to be very sandy. The altitude of this town was around three thousand feet. It was the first airplane ever to make a landing there. Most everybody in the town turned out to see the machine, which bears the name of 'The Sky Pilot.'

“‘The Sky Pilot’ is one of the latest models built by the Curtiss Airplane Corporation, carrying three persons. It is a high powered machine, capable of making high altitudes for crossing the mountains. Having an orange colored body and cream colored wings, it makes the ship very attractive. Under the wings are two designs, a cross and a crown, and lettered on the sides of the fusilage are the words, 'The Sky Pilot.'

"During our stay in Roaring Springs we were asked to make a talk at the First Christian Church on Sunday morning, which we did, explaining the nature of our work and the object of the airplane.

"Upon leaving Roaring Springs, we took a direct compass course across the plains toward Carlsbad, New Mexico. It was a very cloudy day and we were compelled to fly quite low over the country. This was very easy to do because we were flying over level country and landings were quite possible at any point along the way.

"However, for miles and miles we flew over a barren country where there were no signs of life whatever, no railroads, wagon roads, telephone or telegraph lines, and not even a cow-path to be seen. Our gasoline was running low and we were anxious to reach some place of civilization, which we presently found at Tatum, New Mexico, a little town just across the state line of New Mexico. This town was forty-five miles from the nearest railroad. After circling the town several times we made a landing, and immediately nearly the whole population was out to the field and gave us a grand reception, this being the first plane to land at Tatum.

"They listened to a Gospel talk and received the papers. They dismissed the school and let the children see the plane. We were given a fine chicken dinner before leaving. (Before the airplane arrived in Portland, a letter was received from one of the County Commissioners of Tatum, New Mexico, saying, 'We were visited by the Gospel Airplane. It left us a paper. Please send the paper, and we ask the prayers of the saints that we, too, may receive Sanctification and the baptism with the Holy Ghost and fire.')

"We filled our gasoline tank and took off for Carlsbad, New Mexico, continuing across the plains. We reached Carlsbad at 2 p. m. Before we landed, a great crowd of people had gathered at the field to see 'The Sky Pilot.' We left Carlsbad for El Paso, Texas, and circled the town several times, throwing down considerable literature.

"From here we climbed to an altitude of about six thousand feet, to cross the Guadalupe Mountains (The Continental Divide). Here we had to fly above the clouds, which proved to be one of the most beautiful sights anyone could witness, the clouds being penetrated by high mountain peaks. This, also, was a desolate country, and for miles in every direction, there were no signs of habitation.

"We arrived at El Paso and secured gasoline at a Government flying field. We took off and flew along the Mexican border until we reached Hachita, New Mexico, about 5 p. m. Found an ideal landing field and were given a grand reception by an army captain at one of the cavalry border patrol camps. The following day we were detained until 1:30 p. m. on account of rain.

"We took to the air and flew low, under the clouds, to Buckman, New Mexico. Turning west, we went up above the clouds and crossed over the Pyramid Mountains, reaching Cochise, Arizona, at 3:30. p. m. On the outskirts of Cochise, we encountered a heavy rain storm, and flew through it with perfect safety, and after flying over the town for several minutes, we located a good landing field and came down. We were detained here for two days on account of heavy rains and storms.

"We left Cochise in the afternoon for Tucson, Arizona. We crossed several mountain ranges and encountered two severe rain storms, one in a very narrow pass in the mountains where we had to fly low to get below the clouds, and just as we entered the pass a terrific black thunder-cloud came down upon us and entirely enveloped us, making it impossible to see the mountains on either side, or the land below us. We instantly turned the machine around and flew back out of the pass, until the storm passed through, and then we continued our journey.

"We arrived at Tucson, located a beautiful landing field, and came down, and were received by the distributors of the Curtiss Airplanes, who treated us very courteously and gave us a write-up in the daily paper. We stopped there for the night and prepared to leave early the following morning for Los Angeles, which we did, and flew over a number of mountain ranges, encountering some rain on the way, and landed for gasoline at Wellton, Arizona and Yuma. From Yuma, we went northwest, along the Southern Pacific Railroad, past the Great Salt Sea, which is said to be about seven hundred feet below sea level. Passing into the mountains, where we had to fly low on account of heavy clouds, we found very bad air currents, which made it difficult to fly, but we landed safely at Beaumont, California, at 5:45 p. m. This was one of the best flying days that we had, and we covered a distance of about four hundred miles, in six hours.

We left Beaumont the following morning, flying over March Field, Riverside and other towns, dropping literature, arriving in Los Angeles at 9:30 a. m., where we received a grand reception from a band of the Apostolic Faith people, who had prepared lunch and brought to the field. We spent the day with them; having the machine looked over and a few minor adjustments made, and left Los Angeles the following morning for Fresno, crossing the mountains at an altitude of nine thousand feet, over Tehachapi Pass. We went over Bakersfield, Lodi, and other towns enroute, dropping literature along the way.

(A letter was received from Fresno, California, saying, 'We might never have known of this Gospel if your Gospel Airplane had not landed right near our house, and we received a paper. We have been wanting to go to Portland, Oregon, but did not know why; but when your Airplane landed here, we knew God wanted to get us to a place where we could find food for our souls.')

"After leaving Fresno we flew north, landing at Mather Field, where we gassed up and took off for Redding, California, arriving at Redding at 5 p. m. Valleys below, covered with beautiful fruit orchard in bloom, and alfalfa fields, looked very much different than the barren deserts and rugged mountains that we had been flying over. We left Redding at 9 a. m. and flew into the mountains northward for about seventy miles, where we encountered a terrific snow storm, which we hoped would clear away. So we flew around over Sisson, California, for about one hour, at an altitude of over nine thousand feet, but instead of the clouds clearing, they gathered thicker and thicker, and we were compelled to land in this small town at the foot of Mt. Shasta. There was always a break in the clouds over Sisson which gave us a clear view of the city continually. The sun kept shining right down through the rift in the clouds for the machine to go through. It seemed almost impossible to make the landing, right in the heart of the mountains, but we landed in perfect safety. No plane had ever landed there before.

"It was impossible to take off in the small field which we were compelled to land in, so we found it necessary to ship out of the mountains, which we did, and a few days later flew into Portland, where we were given a grand reception at the North Portland landing field by about five hundred of the Apostolic Faith people."

We are now ready to get the airplane on a real working basis, and believe this will open up one of the greatest fields of labor for Christ that has ever been known.

THE GREAT WHITE THRONE JUDGMENT—God will judge the quick and dead according to their works. Rev. 20:11-14. Dan. 12:2. Acts 10:42.

NEW HEAVENS AND NEW EARTH—The Word teaches that this earth, which has been polluted by sin, shall pass away after the White Throne Judgment, and God will make a new

heaven and new earth in which righteousness shall dwell. Matt. 24:35. II Pet. 3:12, 13. Rev. 21:1-3. Isa. 65:17. Isa 66:22.

ETERNAL HEAVEN AND ETERNAL HELL—The Bible teaches that hell is as eternal as heaven. Matt. 25:41, 46. The wicked shall be cast into a burning hell, a lake of fire burning with brimstone forever and ever. Rev. 14:10, 11. Luke 16:24. Mark 9:43, 44.

NO DIVORCE—The Word teaches that marriage is binding for life. Under the New Testament law, the law of Christ, there is but one cause for separation, fornication, and no right to marry again while the first companion lives. Matt. 5:31, 32. Matt. 19:9. Mark 10:11, 12. Luke 16:18. Rom. 7:2, 3.

BIBLE DOCTRINES

IT'S THE OLD TIME RELIGION.

What does it means to be Saved?

It means to have the Blood of Jesus applied to your heart, to have a real knowledge of God's saving grace. It is not the taking on of a profession, joining an organization. It means infinitely more than that. It means to repent with a broken and contrite heart, realizing you are guilty before God, lost and undone unless God saves you; and you pray like the publican of old, "God be merciful to me a sinner," from the depths of your heart. It is a transformation, a mighty reality. Jesus Christ, by the Spirit of God comes into your life and takes out the old carnal desires of the world, and the sins that are ruling in your life; and you know what it is to be truly born of God and live a life without sin. (I John 3:9; Matt. 1:21.) Nothing short of that will ever take you into the Kingdom of Heaven.

Must I Make the Past Right?

Yes, the Word says, "Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance." Matt. 3:8. These fruits of repentance include restoring what we have defrauded or stolen, paying up all honest and just debts and confession where we have wronged our fellow man. Restitution should be complete and to the ones we have wronged. Back debts are never outlawed in God's sight. We must have a "conscience void of offence toward God and man."

Can A Christian Use Tobacco in Any Form?

No. We read in II Cor. 7:1, "Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God." We know that tobacco and snuff are filthy habits and contrary to God's will. The very fact that men have to create an appetite for those things is enough to prove that they are not of God. "What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which we have of

God, and ye are not your own?" I Cor. 6:19. God says, "If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy."

Should I Seek for Sanctification?

Yes. Sanctification is the cleansing of the soul by the Blood of Jesus Christ by which we are made holy and pure in heart. "The Blood of Jesus Christ, God's Son, cleanseth us from all sin." I John 1:7. It is the destruction and eradication of the inbred sin of our fallen nature. "That the body of sin might be destroyed." Rom. 6:6. It is a second, definite, instantaneous work of grace, the deepest work of grace known in the Bible.

Does Every Christian Need the Baptism of the Holy Ghost?

Yes. The Baptism of the Holy Ghost and fire is the gift of power upon the clean, sanctified life. It is the "Promise of the Father," the "Enduement of power from on high"--Luke 24:49, the "Abiding Comforter"--John 14:16-17, "Power to witness"--Acts 1:8, the Pentecostal in-filling of Acts 2:4, "Rivers of Living Water"--John 7:38.

"Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you, and ye shall be witnesses unto me." Acts 1:8.

The Holy Ghost is the Third Person of the Trinity, the Comforter that cometh to abide--not merely a blessing. "And I will pray the Father and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever, even the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth Him not, neither knoweth Him, but ye know Him for He dwelleth with you and shall be in you." John 14:16-17.

"But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance whatsoever I have said unto you." John 14:26.

What Day Should We Keep for the Sabbath?

"The Lord's day," the first day of the week. Jesus Himself established that day as a day of worship. He arose from the dead on the First day of the week and appeared to His disciples several times that day. (Mark, 16:1-20.) Again, the next Lord's day, He appeared to His disciples, Thomas being with them. (John 20:26-29.)

The apostles kept that day. It was on that day the Spirit fell, the wonderful gift of Pentecost. (Acts 2.) On that day they took the Lord's Supper. (Acts 20:7.) On that day they made offerings. (I Cor. 16:2.) On, that day the Lord appeared to John on Patmos and gave the Book of Revelations. (Rev. 1:10, 11.)

God has set His seal upon that day above all others, saving more souls than on any other day, and He has poured out His Spirit in these last days on those that keep and honor the Lord's day, Sabbath.

Is it Necessary to Join a Church?

No: It is not essential to belong to any church organization in order to be a Bible Christian. It is, on the other hand, unscriptural to belong to any church that rejects the truth or any part of the truth.

There is only one true church, or body of Christ: "The church of the first born, which are written in Heaven." Heb. 12:23. The one that is born of God becomes a member of the church or body of Christ, through the Blood of Jesus Christ. "He is the Head of the body, the church." Col. 1: 18.

It is only by the Blood of Jesus Christ in the heart, witnessed by the Spirit, that a soul becomes a member of the church of Christ. If you are joined to Christ and born again you are already a member of His church.

Do the Souls of the Departed Sleep in the Grave?

No. The Bible declares that the saved dead are with Christ in Heaven and the wicked dead enter upon a state of punishment or suffering at death. "Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was, and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it." Eccl. 12:7. "And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." Acts 7:59. Christ said to the dying thief, "Today shalt thou be with me in Paradise." Paul had a desire to depart and he with Christ, which was far better. Phil. 1:23. "The wicked shall be turned into hell and all the nations that forget God," Psalms 9:17. "The rich man died also, and in hell he lifted up his eyes." Luke 16:22-23.

Will Jesus Reveal the Day of His Coming?

No, He said, "Watch, therefore, for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come." (Matt. 24:42.) "But of that day and hour knoweth no man." (Matt. 24:36.) We know by many signs that the time is near, but no man knows the day or hour. Many false prophecies have gone forth, setting the day, and have always failed because they were not according to the Word of God.

What is the Rapture?

The coming of Christ in the clouds, unseen to the world, to catch away His waiting bride. This is the Rapture of the saints. "The Lord Himself shall descend from Heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds." I Thess. 4:16-17. "We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump." I Cor. 15:51-52.

There will be those that will be left. "Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left." Matt. 24:40-41.

What is the Revelation of Jesus Christ?

His second appearance, coming to earth in power and great glory, "with ten thousands of His saints" and all the holy angels with Him. "Behold, He cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him." Rev. I:7. He is coming, not as the lowly prophet of Nazareth, but "With eyes as a flame of fire and on His head many crowns." "And He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath

of Almighty God. And He hath on His vesture and on His thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS." Rev. 19:11-16.

What is the Marriage Supper of the Lamb?

The Word teaches that Christ's spotless bride who has suffered on earth and gone through the humiliation with Him, bearing His cross, will be ushered into the Marriage Supper of the Lamb at the First Resurrection, Rev. 19:7-9. Jesus Himself will come forth and serve them, Luke 12:37. The bride will have part in the "new song," and "follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth," and will stand with Him on Mt. Zion. Rev. 14:1-3. When Jesus descends in the clouds at the sound of the trump of God, His saints will meet Him in the clouds. I Thess. 4:16-17. The Marriage Supper will take place in Heaven, and they will then receive their rewards. Luke 19:12-19. I Peter 5:4. Luke 14:14. Rev. 22:12.

What is the Great Tribulation?

It is that most awful period of the world's history, spoken of by our Lord in Matt. 24:21, and Mark 13:9. It will be a "time of trouble such as was not from the beginning of the world." It is "The time of Jacob's trouble." Jer.30:7. "The Indignation." Isa. 26:20-21. "And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time; and at that time Thy people shall be delivered, everyone that shall be found written in the book." Dan. 12:1. "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be." Matt. 24:21. The vials of God's wrath will be poured out on the earth. Rev. 8th, 9th and 16th chapters. Mal. 4: 1.

What is the Millennium?

The Millennium is the coming thousand years of the literal reign of Jesus Christ on earth, when "The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of His Christ." Rev. 11:15. It is the glorious kingdom of God which Jesus declared should come, and is to be actually established on this earth.

Daniel the prophet saw the kingdom of God. In a vision he saw a Stone cut out of the mountain without hands, that smote the image and became a great mountain and filled the whole earth. Dan. 2:34, 35. "In the days of these kings shall the God of Heaven set up a Kingdom, which shall never be destroyed." Dan. 2:44.

The great Millennium of a thousand years of peace will be ushered in at the coming back of Jesus Christ, after Tribulation, to reign on the earth. He will come to this earth in power and great glory followed by the armies of Heaven on white horses, ten thousands of His saints and all the holy angels with Him. Satan will then be bound a thousand years. Rev. 20:2. The knowledge of the Lord shall cover the earth as the waters cover the sea. "The Lord shall be King over all the earth." 14:9.

What is the White Throne Judgment?

The final great Judgment of the world. The time is coming when the mighty God, the Creator of Heaven and earth, will sit upon His throne and assemble the quick and dead to be judged according to their works. The millions that have lived on earth will appear to meet their earthly record before God. The glorified of the first resurrection will be present, not to be judged but to

sit with Christ in His throne. The living nations will be there, just and unjust; and the dead, their bodies raised from the dust, will meet their final reward. "And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the Book of Life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works." Rev. 20:12.

Will This Earth Be Destroyed?

Yes. The Scriptures teach that the heavens and earth that now are shall be dissolved, destroyed and pass away. The heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up." II Peter 3:10. Matt. 24:35. Heb. 1:10-12.

This earth which has been polluted by sin is destined to be destroyed after the Millennium. John the revelator said, "I saw a Great White Throne, and Him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them." Rev. 20:11.

"And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea." Rev. 21:1. "We, according to His promise, look for new heavens, and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness." II Peter 3:13. "Behold. I create new heavens and a new earth." Isa. 65:17. The redeemed shall inherit the new heavens and earth which shall endure forever, and reign with Christ thru all eternity.

Who Will Compose the Bride of Christ?

The body of overcomers that will escape the Tribulation that is to be poured out on the world. "Come, My people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee; hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast. For behold, the Lord cometh out of His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain." Isa. 26:21.

"Come hither, I will show thee the bride, the Lamb's wife." (Rev. 21:9-11.) "Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints." Rev. 19:7-8.

The overcomers, the bride of Christ, will rule with Him on earth during the Millennium. "And the armies which were in Heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean." Rev. 19:14. "He that overcometh, and keepeth My works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations." Rev. 2:26. "We shall reign on the earth." Rev. 5:10. "Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world?" I Cor. 6:2. Mal. 3:18. Luke 19:12-19.

The saints shall reign with Christ, their bodies being raised and glorified in the first resurrection. I Cor. 15:51, 52. "And they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.-- They shall be priests of God and Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years." Rev. 20:4-6.

DOES GOD PERFORM MIRACLES TODAY?

There is a great cloud of witnesses that "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever." Many with cancers, consumption and all manner of incurable diseases have been healed. Others carried home on stretchers, God has made them every whit whole. They are standing as living witnesses in this Mission.

The doctors and nurses had said how long it would be before he would be able to walk at all. But God instantly touched him, and he walked back and forth, praising the great God of Heaven for an hour. Oh, it is wonderful to trust God in the hour of sorest need."

"My mother broke her arm by cranking a gasoline engine, when she lived 18 miles out in the country, and she came to the Mission, and God instantly healed her arm, and she went back to her home and went right on with her work canning fruit, and using her arm."

A woman that was paralyzed, had been sitting in her chair for three long years, and someone gave her a Mission paper. She got out of that chair and walked, and she has been doing her work for several months. She lives a little way out of Portland.

That wonderful resurrection power.

People get fanatical and think all they have to do is to sit down and enjoy the blessings they got in their heart. They do not want to lose what they have. Well, the way to keep it is to put it out to usury for the Master. "And it came to pass, that when He was returned, having received the Kingdom,

then He commanded these servants to be called unto Him, to whom He had given the money, that He might know how much every man had gained by trading." Luke 19:15.

Every child of God has received a talent. You received your talent, when Christ came into your heart and life. Some may have two, some three, some five, some ten, but everyone has a talent. You may say, "I don't know that I have any talent at all." That is not the point. You are to be obedient and faithful to God, and do what He wants you to do. Some have a talent of praying for others, some have a gift on another line. It is a wonderful thing to have a talent to do the least thing for God.

You may want a talent to do some great thing. Well, you might begin by letting that talent be used in praying for souls about the altar. Be satisfied with the place God gives you, but reaching out that this talent might be wholly given to God. That brings that freedom and faithfulness in the spirit. So few have their talent directly in usury. They are so wrapped up in themselves. You have the talent in your possession, but is it God's talent or are you holding it for yourself? When the talent is turned into use for the Lord, then you are not your own.

The Rewards of Service.

"Then came the first saying, Lord, Thy pound hath gained ten pounds," And He said, Well, thou good servant; because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities. Ana the second came, saying, Lord, Thy pound hath gained five pounds." Now, the Master did not reproach him because his pound had not gained as much as the first, because we have not all the same ability. But He said, "Be thou also over five cities." Luke 19:16-19.

And another came saying, "Lord, here is Thy pound, which I have kept laid up in a napkin." And He said, "Out of thine own mouth will I judge thee, thou wicked servant." Luke 19:22. It is a serious thing to withhold from God the service due unto Him. "Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down and cast into the fire."

And He said unto them that stood by, "Take from him the pound, and give it to him that hath ten pounds." You see what a premium God places on the one that is faithful in His service. We know of many that have withheld from God, and they went into eternity, and as far as we know, they will never see the pearly gates; while others consecrated everything in their possession, and the Lord gave them back much more than they had in the beginning.

You Can Be An Overcomer

Have you the real faith in your soul that can meet every opposition, and mount up with wings as eagles, and run and not be weary, and walk and not faint? It is a wonderful thing to have that faith.

Give God your best. It is a wonderful thing to give, good measure, pressed down and running over, and it shall be given to you in like measure. Many say, "I want God's best, I would give everything in the world to get it." But will you yield all to God? Why don't you give your whole life to the Lord? Just make an entire surrender. Throw your life into the hands of God for service. Lay your life at the foot of the cross, and you will find what it means to reap the reward of that unreserved consecration to God.

Jesus says, "Occupy till I come." You cannot occupy in the Lord's service till you are really consecrated to God. It is all summed up in that scripture, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might." It means a sanctified heart, made holy through the Blood of Jesus Christ.

"And he that overcometh, and keepeth My works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations; and he shall rule them with a rod of iron. – even as I received of My Father." Rev. 2:26-27. He is coming back to this earth with ten thousands of His saints on white horses, to execute judgment upon the ungodly. And the saints of God that are full overcomers will come back with Him, and have power over the nations. (Rev.19:11-15; Jude 14, 15.)

SPIRITUALISM

"AN ABOMINATION UNTO THE LORD."

The promulgation of Spiritualism in England has been enormously increased during the past five years, or since the beginning of the war. Even judges on the bench and ministers standing in the pulpit are tampering with that terrible sin, which like some poisonous weed, threatens to cover the earth. In the United States it is greatly on the increase. What could be worse than this awful deception? Demons feigning themselves to be the spirits of the dead are deluding the people, so-called Christians communing with familiar spirits.

Spiritualism arose in 1848 and had its thousands of followers; and many people were led off into the awful sin of impurity by it. This is a matter of history. The communing with familiar spirits is as old as the Bible. The Egyptians and the inhabitants of Canaan were sorcerers, workers of black art. The nations practiced it, and the heathen do to this day.

God forbade it, and would not suffer His people to consult with witches or have any part with witchcraft, which is plainly described in the Word, and declared to be "an abomination unto the Lord." Deut. 18:12.

Other systems have arisen, partaking of the same spirit, and all denying the power of the Blood of Jesus Christ, Christian Science, Theosophy, New Thought and other kindred falsities. They have their millions of followers today.

This is according to the unerring word of prophecy. The Apostle Paul said, "Now, the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils." (I Tim. 4:1)

Christ recognized the presence of demons and demon possessed men and women and cast out the evil spirits with His word, and gave His disciples power to do the same. We read of how the man in the tombs was delivered, and Mary Magdalene. Souls that are bound by evil spirits are being delivered these days, for Jesus said, "These signs shall follow them that believe; in My name shall they cast out devils." (Mark 16:17)

Many today have departed from the Word of God, seeking the supernatural. Not finding anything to satisfy them in the formal churches, and not being willing to seek the God of the Bible, they have turned to the darkened rooms, to the séances and hired mediums, and unconsciously to the powers of darkness. A great deal of it is trickery and deception on the part of the mediums; but there is an evil, demon power working, as with the sorcerers and wizards and witches of old. It is one of the abominations and deceptions of these last days, that will most certainly bring down the wrath of God upon their souls.

The workings of the spirit-medium, christian scientist practitioner, theosophist, hypnotist, clairvoyant, fortuneteller, magnetic-healer and kindred spirits, are all witchcraft and the work of evil spirits.

All these are an abomination unto the Lord, for He says, "There shall not be found among you anyone*** that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits or a wizard or a necromancer. For all that do these things are an abomination unto the Lord." Deut. 18:10-12.

Such also are the "sorcerers" of which God said, "They shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone." Rev. 21:8. A child of God will have nothing to do with these unclean spirits and works of darkness.

You will meet temptations. God says we shall be tempted. But He has promised to give power over them. When He saves your soul He makes you an overcomer.

What will it mean to enter in and receive the reward of the overcomer, and hear that wonderful voice say, "Enter thou into the joy of thy Lord?"

We read the wonderful chapters in the book of Revelations, but there has not been told us one fraction of the things God has prepared for them that love Him. It could not have been possible for it all to be put into print. The world could not contain the books to describe the things God has prepared for His people.

Does it pay to go through with God, to endure a few of the oppressions of this age? I should say it does,

"A little while the cross to bear,

"THE MARK OF THE 'BEAST.'"

The Apostle Paul says (II Thess. 2:1-12), that before the day of Christ could come, there must come a great falling away. After this, a terrible personage would arise, called "the man of sin." The Antichrist, "the son of perdition." This man will come in the power of satan, and will blaspheme God and exalt himself and be worshipped as god, deceiving the nations by great signs and wonders. The whole world will worship him, except those whose names are written in the

Lamb's book of life. (Rev. 13) And when this man of sin is at the height of his career, the Son of God will come in His glory, and destroy him and all his followers. (Rev. 19:20, 21.)

"The mark of the beast" is a most deadly and terrible mark, because it will mean that person is eternally lost. (Rev. 14:9, 10.) People think this is far in the future, but there are ungodly movements such as lodges, unions, uprisings that are really the Antichrist spirit. God says, "Come out from among them." The time is not far distant when the Antichrist will arise, and cause every man to receive a mark in the right hand or forehead, and that no man may buy or sell without the mark. The papers tell of terrible suffering and slaughter in Russia, how that many have been killed and compelled to dig their own graves, and were cast into them before they were hardly dead.

A letter came recently from some true Christians in Finland that are standing for this whole Gospel. One family have come from Russia and are standing true to God. The people went through terrible suffering. One Christian man made his escape from the reign of terror in Russia. He told how they compelled people to receive a mark, or brand, in the arm. This is according to prophecy. (Rev. 13:17.) We are not far from the Tribulation. The Antichrist spirit is working in the earth. It was in Paul's time, (II Thess. 2:7) and it certainly is heading up in these days, and the call of God is to be ready, to put on the whole armor of God, and watch unto prayer.

THE INFLUENZA, ONE OF THE PLAGUES OF THE LAST DAYS.

The people of God should pray that God will stay the plague that swept away twelve million last year. This lost world is dying and going on unrepentant, rushing down the broad way to hell. Five hundred thousand deaths were caused in the United States by the influenza last year, five times our loss in the war; and it is generally believed by the medical world that the succeeding years will show frightful after effects, unless remedies can be found. They assure us that the plague will appear again. But we know that God holds these things in His own power, and prayer moves the arm that holds the world.

One physician in New York says he expects the greatest epidemic the world has ever known to break out again. The people of God should pray, that the hand of judgment might be stayed, and souls might repent and turn to God, as they did in days of old, when God repented of the evil that He said He would bring upon them.

It is a significant fact that the medical world was helpless in the face of the plague. It is a mystery that men cannot fathom; but those who study the Bible know that the Book of God foretold that plagues should come in the last days. God is speaking to a Christ-rejecting world, calling men to repentance.

If you are a sufferer, put God to the test. Lay your sick body at the foot of the cross. Press that Bible to your bosom, and say, "Oh God, I will trust you; I will believe you." "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever."

"GOD PARDONED ALL MY SIN."

I am so glad I ever heard these people tell what it meant to be a real Christian. So many years I was a church member, but I never got any satisfaction out of it. I never had any knowledge of God. Eight years ago, I heard these people tell that Christians lived without sin. O, I am so glad I heard it, after I had tried and struggled, studied Christian Science, Russellism, Mormonism and Dowieism, but somehow they did not register true in my heart, because I knew that Jesus was the Son of God. I held to the Bible all my life.

I went into a big tent where these people were holding a meeting, and heard the Shepherd's voice. They told me that Christians had victory. And I said, "O God, if you will give me what those people have, I will forsake my sins." I was glad to find the way out of my sins and misery. I got on my knees, and God pardoned all my sins; and for the first time in my life, I knew I was right with God.

Every crooked thing I ever did came up before me. When a girl, I stole 15 dollars where I worked, in a department store, right in the city where I was raised. My people were highly respected. I would not have anybody know that for anything in the world. Many a time I wished I hadn't done it. I wished I could make it right without the proprietor knowing it. But when God saved my soul, I wrote back to that man and sent him back his money.

I am so glad for a life of peace and victory. I am so glad for this wonderful Gospel, that Jesus did not die in vain, but He died that we might be redeemed from sin.

A minister in this Gospel was given a vision of these last days. It was of a great harvest field of ripened grain; the heads bent over, and the sky overhead black with clouds, as of a coming storm. The reapers were working swiftly, to gather the grain, binding the sheaves; while the heavens grew darker and darker, and now and then red flashes of light lit up the scene. It spoke of the fulfillment of prophecy and the shortness of time. Soon all will be over.

The Days of the Martyrs.

Thousands have sealed their testimony with their blood, dying in dungeons, at the stake, by the sword, being beheaded, drowned, hurled from precipices, torn by wild beasts, dying by every means of torture that cruelty and hatred could invent; leaving a testimony of most wonderful victory and joy in the midst of sufferings, that should be an inspiration to every child of God in these last days.

The martyr Ignatius, a friend of John the apostle, was thrown to the wild beasts in Rome. He wrote before his death, "Let fire and the cross. let the companies of wild beasts, let breaking of

bones and tearing of limbs, let grinding of the whole body and the malice of the devil come upon me; so that I may enjoy Jesus Christ. He is my gain, laid up for me."

Another faithful martyr, being led out to the stake, when they placed on his head a paper crown on which images of devils and the word "arch-heretic" were painted, said, "I am glad to wear this crown of ignominy for the love of Him who wore a crown of thorns." He went to the stake with joy, singing in the midst of the fagots his song of triumph, praise and glory to the Redeemer."

Another said, "I fear not the fire that burns only for a moment, but thou hast heard of that which burns forever and ever." His countenance was full of joy and peace. Being bound to the stake, he prayed, "I thank Thee that Thou hast graciously thought me worthy of this day and hour, that I may receive a portion in the number of Thy martyrs."

Another being threatened with torment, said, "We are willing to endure torture for the Lord Jesus Christ. We are even happy at the idea, and shall have confidence at the awful tribunal of our Lord and Savior." He, with others, was sentenced to be scourged and afterwards beheaded.

Another when told he was to be slain, said. "God be thanked."

Another sang with joy and a loud voice as he was led out to the burning. As the wood was placed around him he sang. "Hail, happy day." Then he said, "Into Thy hands, O Lord, I commend my spirit."

A sainted woman in England, after being shamefully mangled on the rack, was carried out to be burned. She preserved to the last an angel's countenance and a smiling face. Three other martyrs that were to suffer with her were cheered and comforted by her exhortation and example. Before the fire was applied, she was offered a pardon if she would recant. She said, "I did not come here to deny my Lord and Master." Her death was one of wonderful victory.

Another martyr said, "Oh, what am I, Lord, that Thou shouldst thus magnify me? Is this Thy wont to send for such a wretch and hypocrite as I have been, in a fiery chariot, as Thou didst for Elias?" At the stake he knelt with a fellow martyr in prayer, and rising took a fagot in his hand and kissing both it and the stake, said to his brother martyr, "Be of good comfort; We shall have a merry supper with the Lord this night." He entered the flames as if it had been a fresh gale on a hot summer day. And the last words on his lips were, "Strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, that leadeth to salvation, and few there be that find it." At that moment he reached the threshold of his Heavenly home.

Another martyr, as he was about to be led from his cell to the headman's block, opened his Bible and said, "Lord, open to me a promise in this awful hour." He opened the Word and his eyes fell on the promise, "Perfect love casteth out fear." He closed the Book and said, "Enough, Lord, for time and eternity." He was led to the stake, and laid his head peacefully on the block.

Many children were also among the martyrs for Christ. As two women ascended the scaffold where they were to be executed, they sang a hymn, and one of them, a young woman of 20, said

joyfully. "Behold, I hear my Beloved saying unto me, 'Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.'" They died with great victory.

Two Christian women were sentenced to be drowned. They were bound to stakes planted in the sea, where the incoming tide would strangle them. A great crowd stood on the shore. Every effort was made to get them to recant. As the waters arose, they sang with a clear voice. One of them a young girl of 18 was drowned, and a relative of hers rushed out into the waves, took her in his arms, and begged her to recant. She replied firmly. "I will not, I am one of Christ's children, let me go." And she went to be with Christ.

"WORKING IN THE OLD MILL, GOD SPOKE TO ME."

God brought me here clear from old Wisconsin. I was working in the old mill down in the Northern Pacific, and He came down and said. "This is your last chance." I says, "God, if you will keep me till I get to that old hall, I will give you my life." I gave God my life. I fell down at the feet of Jesus and He saved my soul.

For 50 years I was bound in sin. I ran from the officers, to keep from being arrested, a drunkard, a gambler, an old backslider that really knew God at one time, tonight redeemed by the precious Blood of Jesus. God sent me back to Wisconsin and Indiana to straighten up my back tracks.

I chewed tobacco tobacco for 35 years, and the instant God saved me, the habit left me, and that is about 11 years ago. I wore a truss for 18 years, and God removed that, and healed me. One time I had Bright's disease, and the doctor said it was the worst case he ever saw, and I came to Portland 2,500 miles to get these people to pray for me, because I could not find a man there to pray for me. I knew if I could get to these people, God would heal me, and He did. There is nothing in the world that would turn me back to the beggarly elements of the world. I do love to tell sinners what God has done for me. For 11 years I have been going around distributing papers for God. He has put something in this old man's soul that is going through with Him.

It takes old time repentance to get salvation, just as much as in Bible days.

RAILROAD CONDUCTOR SAVED.

I was a crooked railroad conductor. I run between Chicago and Milwaukee when I came among these people. I belonged to the Masonic order, had a beautiful mask of hypocrisy on, but these wonderful testimonies went down under the sham and make-believe and showed me my heart, a miserable sinner on the way to hell. I thank God, this Gospel took me out of the pit of sin. I found it did a wonderful thing in my life, delivered me from sin.

I was a proud, stubborn, independent man, but the power of God was able to break down my proud heart, and show me it was an abomination in His sight. Had everything I needed in this world, but I was not satisfied with a good position, a good salary, a good home. There was something in me that called for reality.

I began to steal money from the railroad company. I stole from them for years, covered up my life. No one knew it, not even my wife or the men on the run with me. But when I heard these testimonies, I knew I would have to meet those things in eternity, if not here.

I heard the testimonies of the dope fiend, the drunkard, the fallen woman that had been delivered, and I said, if God would give me that, I would give Him my life." I held up my hand, and said, "Pray for me." I got down on my knees at this pine bench, and asked God to be merciful to me a sinner, and God heard my cry, and rolled the burden of sin off my soul, for He had saved me and given me deliverance from the things that had me bound.

A few days later found me writing back to the railroad company, a man that had been a brother Mason of mine, telling them I had been stealing from them for years. It took God to make me do that. I thank God I had grace to go and ask people to forgive me. They freely forgave me and I

praise God for the power in the Blood of Jesus, that takes sin out, and gives you power to live without sin. It takes out the lying, the stealing and double crossing, and makes you straighten up your crooked life. I can recommend this Gospel to all.

A BRAKEMAN-"OVERSEAS WITH THE 62ND ENGINEERS."

I was a brakeman since I was 18, fired and switched on the railroads all over the country. I remember the night I joined the brotherhood. I called all the old switchmen and gave them a drink. They said, "You've got 95,000 brothers back of you now." I would break the box car seals and steal whiskey, going over the road. I lost one job after another over the whiskey route, couldn't hold a decent job.

A few years ago, I staggered up Second Street, and caught the sound of these testimonies on the street corner. I stood in the crowd, a little cigarette in my mouth, my shoes all dirty from the brine where I had been working down in the old hide house. I stood and listened, and I soon saw they had the genuine thing. They told me they had been working all day, and God had kept them clean on the job. One fellow looked me in the eye and said, "When you get the old time religion, you can look anybody in the eye." My eyes went down. I could not look anybody square in the eye.

I heard young men that had been over the same route tell that Jesus Christ had taken every appetite for sin out of their life. I did not pass it up. They had me beat a thousand miles. I came up the stairs to the Mission Hall. I did not know how to pray, but I asked God to save my soul. I got down on my old knees, and God Almighty changed my heart. Men, tonight I am glad I am a Christian.

I went back and faced my pals, and told them what had happened. The men were playing cards, with their wine and cigarettes. I took a little Testament out of my pocket and told the old gang I had salvation, no more drink and cigarettes for me.

I knew it would mean to go back over a life of crime. I knew I would have to face the penitentiary bars. I had hundreds of dollars of restitution to make. I thank God, I am clean before God and man today. I had robbed a saloon in St. Louis of about \$400 cash. I wrote to that man and told him I was the man and confessed the crime, and I got a fine letter back. Then I had to write to the railroad company and tell them how I had broken open box cars and stolen stuff.

I was in the American Army, went over to France with the 62nd Engineers, brakemen from all the roads in the country, and before we left the training camp in Indiana, they knew that "Blackie" as they called me, had religion. I want to tell you that God Almighty kept me on the job. I was on the advance sector, a conductor on the road. I put in 24 to 25 hours on a trip. God put the thing in my heart that stood the test.

I am glad I proved the power of God to keep under all circumstances. They let me go into all the big towns in France, I carried an identification card. Sin was on every hand, sin I never knew existed. I had every chance to go into sin, but the One that saved me kept me clean. I am glad that on my discharge paper was written, "An excellent character." God can take a bum and make

an excellent character out of him.

"IN THE LUMBER CAMPS, DRINKING AND CAROUSING."

I thank God, I got in touch with Jesus Christ, and got saved from sin. I thank God, I made my way up the old stairs eight years ago into a Mission, and heard that God Almighty could take a drunken logger, and make him what he ought to be. I tell you, that sounded wonderful to me. I was ready, the minute they closed, to give God the balance of my life. And I knew when I started down that aisle that God was back of me. I knew something had struck my life. I was trembling like a leaf.

I threw myself at that altar and cried to God for mercy. I didn't care what my friends thought. I was dead to everything. And I had not been there many minutes when I knew God had done something in my life. I got on my feet praising God, and I longed to tell it. I met the old gang and I had the victory.

My father got me to drinking when just a little fellow. I would be so drunk I could hardly sit on the wagon seat coming home from town. I would stagger into the kitchen where my old mother was, and see her around the kitchen with the tears rolling down her face. I had a terrible temper. Many times I swore I would take my older brother's life. I would get in a rage many times, and throw my hat on the ground and tramp on it and swear.

I was running a bowling alley when God found me, nothing good left in my life. When I went back and met the old gang I had been drinking and carousing with, I let them know that Jesus Christ had saved my soul. They could see the change in my life. I had committed crimes against the government that would put me behind the bars for years, but I confessed them out after God saved me.

I have never had a desire for the things of the world. The temper is gone; the drinking and carousing left me. I know tonight I have the old time religion. I have had eight years to prove what God did for me.

"ON MY KNEES AT THE WORK BENCH."

I was a deacon in the church, but I came to the place where they told the deacon he needed salvation. I came off night duty, and my wife said to me, "You better come with me to church this morning, and hear these people down at Front and Burnside." I thank God that ever I came. I heard the testimonies go forth, and they appealed to my heart. I heard the preacher stand up with the Word of God, and preach to hypocrites, people that were wearing tags, making other people believe they were Christians, and down in their heart they had no reality. I thought that the preacher was pointing right down to me.

I turned it down, and said I would have nothing to do with this salvation. But the next Sunday morning found me in the same place. I heard the voice of God that morning. Something compelled me to come. My wife said, "You better go with me." I said, "Don't you ask me to go

to that place any more, I have gone for my last time." Went out to the back, lit my cigar, and was going to smoke the thing off. God spoke to me right there, and I said, "Just wait a minute. I believe I'll go." Again the Word sunk deep into my heart. I was a miserable man. I ran down those stairs in a rage, my fists clenched, my teeth set, said I would never come in this place again.

I went to my work in the Board of Trade Building. But God spoke to me in the motor room that day out of Heaven. Wherever I went, the voice of God was speaking down in my heart, until at last I dropped on my knees, and started to pray. My heart was beating faster and faster; I was trembling from the crown of my head to the soles of my feet. What was that? It was conviction that God placed on my heart.

That moment I dropped on my knees; I cried aloud; I wept and prayed, "Oh God, be merciful to me a sinner," and the Lord saved me. Before five minutes, I jumped to my feet and I could say I was saved, without a shadow of a doubt. It seemed to me the Heavens opened.

The boy that was running the elevator in that building said to the other fellows, "You better go up. There's something the matter with Jack; he's crying and he's praying and asking God to save him." Thank God, my old knees ever struck the ground, and I called on the Son of God, and He delivered me, and put a victory down in my heart that has stood for six years.

I jumped to my feet and started to praise the Lord. I dug down in my old pocket and got my cigars and pipe and chewing plug, and flung them out the door. Nobody ever said to me, "You'll have to stop smoking the old cigar before you will get to Heaven." I flung them right out.

I hurried through with my work, and ran up the street and up these stairs and into this Mission, and said, "The Lord has saved me." They knew I was saved. It changed the whole course of my life. It was God that did the whole thing. There was a bonfire that night in my home – my box of cigars and Russell's no-hell doctrine. I tried to make myself believe there was no hell. Thank God, I believe the whole Word of God.

God took the sin out of my heart. Never had a defeated moment since God saved me, six years ago. This is a salvation that you can shout it out at the work bench, on the street, wherever you are. It takes the weak backbone out, and puts a backbone of steel in you, makes you stand four-square for God. It's the peace of Heaven down in this heart of mine. It keeps me every day, every moment of the day, with the old time religion. I wish you could feel the joy and peace that comes down in your heart, when you get the old time religion.

You do not have to wait till you die to get rid of sin and be happy. You can have it right here. You can have the peace resting in your soul that is deeper than the sea. The peace that God gives is deeper than any earthly thing. It is fathomless, and God will give it to you.

SAVED AT HER WORKING PLACE.

It was in the basement of the place where I worked, that Jesus broke the chains that had me bound. I was a broken-hearted woman down in the blackness of sin. I did not believe God would save me. I did not believe this wonderful salvation was for a wretch like me. I had sworn I would jump off one of these bridges before I would confess my sins; but I praise God tonight I have had five years of peace. No more does my guilty conscience haunt me and make me walk the floor at night. I tried Spiritualism and Christian Science, but they could not reason hell out of me.

I am so glad I came to this Mission five years ago, through curiosity, just expected to go out and spend eternity in a devil's hell. I thank God, He talked to me. They said Jesus would forgive my sins. I went down the stairs with tears, in my lost condition, but these people prayed. How I praise God, He did not give me up. He followed me to the place of business where I work. At last I looked up to God and said, "I surrender all." And He rolled that burden of sin and crime away.

Oh, how I praise God, His Blood washed my sins away. He blotted out the blackest sins a woman could commit. He took the murder out of heart, restored my soul to spotless purity. I was ashamed to look my family in the face. People counted me a good Christian woman, but when they called me good, it was like a dagger to my heart. I had once known the love of Jesus but turned my back on Him. I am glad tonight it is real in my life.

It made me stand among my friends and tell them of the wonderful change. They know the theatre, the grill rooms, the ball room, cannot tempt me from the path of peace. The diamonds and fine clothes have lost their charms for me. He saved my husband, and united our home. He healed me when the doctors said I would have to go on the operating table. The Blood of Jesus has ransomed me from that black midnight of sin and sorrow. I love and magnify His Name for the wonderful peace He put in my heart.

A CAR SHOP MECHANIC.

I praise God for the old time religion, the Gospel of Jesus Christ that saved this Polish Catholic from sin. The Lord brought me here from the big Catholic church and I heard the truth. Down in the Albina car shops, a brother from this Mission told me what God did for him. He gave me one of the papers. I took it home and my wife read to me "The same Jesus, yesterday, today and forever." I never heard that in the Catholic church in all my life. I told my wife, "We got to go down there, see what these people got."

One Sunday afternoon, I left the Catholic church, holy mass, crucifix, statues, idols, holy water. I came here and sat way back. Just to step in the hall, I knew these people served God. They got the old time religion I never heard about, but Jesus revealed it to me. I could not talk much English – just blaspheme the name of Jesus and get along at my work, but God revealed to me that Jesus was real.

I felt the glory and sweetness and power, and I felt like a little child. It was so wonderful. These people got down to pray, and I started to pray just like I prayed all my life, to Mary, and Peter and John and all the host of heaven. Jesus convicted me right there, smote me just like death. I

couldn't pray no more. I lifted up my head and these people prayed with the mighty power. I said, "Jesus, I want to be alive."

I came and knelt down here, and these people gather around and prayed for Jesus to do something for this man, "Open Heaven to him." I melt right down, repent of my sins and confess, ask Jesus to be merciful. God destroyed every sin, every habit, every appetite and desire. I got on my feet – "New creature in Christ Jesus" – old things pass away and everything become new. I got joy and peace I never knew.

The sins I confessed to the Catholic priest – not one been forgiven. I confessed in the churches in Poland and Belgium, prayed in seven churches, had the holy water, the scapular on my body – we prayed every day, but thank God, Jesus on my knees was real. He destroyed everything and set me free. It was wonderful.

It took me five years to straighten my crooked life. I went back to Ohio and Michigan to make things right. I sent a box of tools back. The priest told me I did not have to do it. The priest in the old country forbid me to have a Bible. I praise God, I got a Bible. I don't have to go to hell or purgatory, but I'm going to Heaven. I believe the teachings of Jesus Christ and the apostles, nothing more or less. No pope, not holy water, but God in the heart. If I lose my head for my testimony and the Word of God, that would be a blessing to me. Praise God for the real Gospel from Heaven that saves from sin.

"STOOD BEHIND A DRUG COUNTER FOR YEARS."

For years of my life I stood behind the drug store counter. I never worked for a man in my life, up to the time God saved my soul, but what I stole his money. In a Mission for the first time I heard these testimonies that there was victory over sin. They told me God saved them from sin and kept them out of sin. I went down before God and repented of my sins, and God, for Christ's sake, forgave my sins, and gave me power to tell the truth and pay back the money, and make right the wrongs I had done. And for nine years I have been a real Christian.

When I came among these people, I would scoff at Divine healing. I heard these people tell how God healed all diseases that medicine could not reach, consumption and cancers and such things. I said I could trust God for my body as well as my soul. I threw away my medicine, threw away my glasses I had worn for 20 years, and God has healed me every time I have been sick. I have tried this Gospel out in the time o f trouble, and He has not failed me a single time. I know it is real.

When the Heart is right with God, It will be right with every living creature. Your conscience will be void offence toward God and man.

"I WAS A FALLEN WOMAN."

God dug me out of an awful pit of sin. I was a fallen woman. I used to spend my Sundays hidden away in those awful places of shame. I remember once I lived near a church, and as I would hear those songs ring out; "Jesus lover of my soul," I said, "Oh, if I could only find Him."

There was no hope for me. I tried many times to reform myself. Even went back to my mother, and thought surely I could reform, but satan drove me back into that awful life of shame. I lived a double life. I had my life all covered up, I was so ashamed; but one day God broke that chain off my life. I just look back and wonder how I could be such an awful sinner, and for the last five years I have lived without sin.

One day He led me among these people. I found the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the power of God unto salvation. These people laid their hands on me, and prayed and rebuked the devil out of my life. The next day alone in my room, God saved my soul. Oh, I am so glad to be saved.

Nobody knows what it means to my heart to be right with God. Oh, my soul is filled with praises. Oh, I tell you, a fallen woman appreciates this Gospel. It took the mighty God to break those chains. Oh, it is no cheap thing, but it is wonderful to me. Some of my friends were cut off and went to hell in that life, but I know I am redeemed, washed in the Blood. He healed my body. I had to be helped up the stairs when I came to this Mission. Oh, I thank God, Jesus Christ saved my soul. The Blood has cleaned me up.

When I was so heartbroken, I did not know there was such a thing for a human to have in this world. Many a time I would go in my room and say, "Oh God, why did you ever make me, I wish I did not have a soul." But my life was changed when God came in. And I am so glad I can work for an honest living.

A Visit To Our Printing Plant.

We are bending every effort to get the Gospel out to lost and hungry souls. We expect to distribute papers and Gospel messages from the Airplane. The Gospel Autos are carrying them into the jails, streets, lanes and highways. They are being sent through the mail to the ends of the earth, and without charge. No money is ever accepted in any way as payment for this Gospel.

What a wonderful privilege God has given us in these last days. How we thank God for the incoming mail, with its hundreds of requests for prayer, for the wonderful privilege of praying for the suffering and hungry souls, and for the outgoing mail that is reaching over the world.

God is so good to us. He lets us find people to translate our papers into foreign languages. We began to pray that God would give us a paper in the Armenian language, and it was not long till He opened the way. Our own people translate papers into five languages: the Norwegian, Swedish, German, Finnish and Bohemian; also tracts; and we have our papers in four other languages, besides tracts are now being translated into French and Portuguese. They are sent to other lands and many over this land who cannot read English, and they have received this great Gospel through the papers and tracts.

We wish our readers could see the large press that has been installed in our printing plant, at Front and Burnside, that prints, at one impression, the four pages of this paper. We also print Our

Young People's paper, "The Armour Bearer," "The Convict's Hope," the Prison Edition to the Apostolic Faith, and four of our foreign papers. We wish you could see the folding machine, that folds the papers to send to the 20,000 of our readers, the linotype that sets all the type, the job press for tract work; then the mail office that cares for hundreds of letters that constantly pour into the office, with its many typewriters for handling the mail, the mimeograph, the addressograph that stamps the 20,000 addresses on the wrappers; also the other offices, with large desks covered with work.

There is an army of workers for God that have consecrated their lives to His service. God has given us skilled workers among the saints, that count it the greatest privilege to be associated with the Gospel that can scatter the wonderful "glad tidings of great joy." The saints are so rejoiced that God has given us all this wonderful machinery to carry on the Lord's work. We have always had to have the papers printed by sinners, but now no hands but the saints of God handle the work on the papers, and we believe the power of God will rest upon them as it never has before, in blessing and salvation, and healing of the sick.

God performs miracles of healing, and saving souls all over the land wherever the paper finds its way. They fall among people like leaves of healing. We are constantly hearing of hungry souls that have been saved through the papers, and great numbers healed of all manner of diseases. This is the result of the true Gospel wherever it goes, because it is the whole truth, believed, lived and practiced, and God sets His seal upon it.

CONFESSIOIN OF CRIMES.

Never in this generation has there been such confession of crimes, such restitution of stolen goods and money and back debts paid, as has been witnessed in the last fourteen years. The secular papers have published it; the officials of the railroads have been astonished, as they received money for stolen rides on the roads.

Men have sold their property and paid back what they had stolen and where they had defrauded. Others confessed crimes that would have put them behind the bars for the rest of their lives. They gave themselves up, and have been freely forgiven. It follows real Bible salvation.

It takes the Blood of Jesus Christ to make you strong and brave, when you come to face death and the judgment.

There is no place to rectify wrongs after we leave this old world.

Where time ends, eternity begins. When your soul passes out of this world it is launched into an endless eternity. Therefore "Prepare to meet thy God. There is a "House of God eternal in the Heavens." And 1 here is a hell, "Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched."

ETERNAL LIFE OR EYERLASTING DEATH.

Sinner, Jesus has power to come down in that life of yours that has been wrecked by sin, and make you a real Christian, put you on the shining pathway, and cause you to inherit eternal life. He has power to save you from sin. It will not be a mere story that is told you, but it will be a reality. Your desires will change. He will take out the love of the world and sin. You will love the things that are real, pure and genuine.

He took a basin and washed his hands before that throng and said, "I am innocent of the blood of this just person." But that did not clear him of murder. It did not save him from an eternal hell.
